RUFF START/TLC BEHAVIOR ASSISTANT

As a Ruff Start/TLC Behavior Assistant you are responsible for assisting in the behavior evaluation, training and implementing behavior protocols of Shelter dogs being brought to Salinas Valley State prison. You will typically be going 3 days a week to SVSP to work with the shelter dogs and their inmate trainers. You will be teaching the inmates how to train dogs with positive reinforcement along with daily husbandry skills. You will be inside the prison directly working with Level 3 and Level 4 inmates. Duties will include keeping inventory and maintaining the supplies for the dogs, tracking and updating spreadsheets (excel, word and google drive) as well as working with the public, showcasing dogs in the adoption center, play yards, offsite and on media. Ruff Start and TLC dogs are often available by appointment only; you will set up the appointments and meet potential adopters. You will be tracking dog's behavior progress while they are in the Ruff Start/TLC program and even after adoption. This position will include training public dogs on Sundays. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Must have prior animal handling, husbandry and dog training experience. Solid work history and ability to work a Sunday-Thursday schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current & Clean California Driver's License. Starting rate for this position is \$16.00- \$20.00/hour, DOE and Dog Training Certifications.

ANIMAL CARE TECHNICIAN (Fulltime 40 hours a week)

Join our team working behind the scenes providing quality animal care to the hundreds of animals housed in our shelter each year. Work with the entire Animal Care staff to clean kennels and cages, feed and water a variety of domestic animals and livestock, restock animal supplies, assist with medicating sick animals, assist with the training of new employees and restrain animals for examinations, vaccinations and euthanasia, in accordance with established quality animal care and husbandry standards under the supervision of the Animal Care Supervisor. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Animal husbandry background preferred. Solid work history and ability to work a flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current California Driver's License. Starting rate for this position is \$15.00/hour.

MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT Part-time (20 hours a week)

Assist in the all activities related to the regular and preventative maintenance of SPCA buildings and their systems to include heating, air conditioning, ventilation, lighting, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, well & water systems, boilers, welding, painting, equipment installation & repair. Monitors and assures compliance with all established facility and vehicle safety, performance and appearance standards. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Solid work history and ability to work a flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current California Driver's License. Starting rate for this unique position is \$18.00-\$20.00/hour, DOE

REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN
