REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN – (Fulltime 40 hrs/wk: Monday - Friday, 7:30am -4pm)

Take a hands-on role in reducing the population of homeless dogs and cats each year with this rare opportunity in our Veterinary Clinic for a Registered Veterinary Technician. Qualified applicants **must be a California State Certified Licensed RVT**. Ideal candidates will be self-motivated, able to multi-task, have excellent clinical skills and work well with others. Full-time position is Monday – Friday, 7:30am -4pm work shift, and periodic Saturdays. Salary range for these positions are \$29.00 - \$35.00/hour DOE, + \$5,000 Sign on Bonus for Full-time (40hours/week), after 90 days of employment.

TLC PET BEHAVIOR SPECIALIST (Part-time 18 hrs/wk: Friday, Saturday & Sunday, 8:30am-3pm)

The TLC Pet Behavior Specialist provides daily care, enrichment, and behavior training for animals in the TLC program. This position promotes animal welfare through humane handling, behavioral assessment, progress tracking, and adopter education. The specialist also makes recommendations regarding adoption, rescue placement, or humane euthanasia and provides basic dog-handling training to adoption floor volunteers. Ideal candidates will be dependable self-starters, with the ability to learn new duties. Must have prior Animal Handling and husbandry experience. Certified in Pet Behavior Training using positive reinforcement methods is a plus. Solid work history and ability to work a Friday- Sunday schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Salary range for this position is \$20.00 – \$23.00/hour + (DOE & Behavior Certifications).

FOSTER & TRANSFER COORDINATOR (Full-time 40 hrs/wk: Tuesday -Saturday, 8:00am-5pm)

The Foster and Transfer Coordinator is responsible for the training, support, mentoring and guides foster volunteers to raise underage animals and/or assist injured animals by providing exemplary care at volunteer foster homes until adoption. Interfaces with all departments of The SPCA for coordination of vaccinations, medications, medical and behavior treatments, spay/neutering as well as the transferring of pets to other outside animal organizations and agencies. Ideal candidates will be dependable self-starters, with the ability to learn new duties. Must have prior Animal Handling and husbandry experience. Solid work history and ability to work a Tuesday- Saturday schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Salary range for this position is \$21.00 – \$24.00/hour DOE
