VETERINARIANS - Full-time (40 hrs/wk: Monday- Friday 8am-4:30pm)

The SPCA for Monterey County is expanding their HQHV Spay and Neuter and Shelter program and needs **Full-time, Part-time and Contract/Relief Veterinarians** to provide spay/neuter surgeries for public and shelter animals and for companion animal herd-health management in cooperation with shelter leadership and fellow staff veterinarians. The successful candidate

- Must hold or obtain a valid California DVM license and be eligible to hold a DEA registration.
- Must be able to perform routine canine and feline spays and neuters independently. Mentorship available to increase surgical speed and volume to HQHV target of 20-25 procedures per day, and to learn to independently handle more challenging patients (geriatric, obese, pregnant, pyometra, cryptorchid)
- Is willing and able to work one Saturday per month in exchange for a weekday off.
- Has a minimum of one year veterinary experience, preferably in a shelter or spay/neuter clinic setting.
- Participates in training staff, volunteers, students from our local accredited VA/RVT training program, and occasional veterinary student externs.
- Conducts shelter rounds in rotation with fellow veterinary staff members.
- Reports to the VP of Shelter and Clinic Services

The salary range for this position is \$135,000.00/yr- \$175,000+ DOE, including a \$20,000 Signing Bonus. The SPCA covers licensure, DEA registration, relevant continuing education and approved travel expenses, AVMA, ASV and VIN memberships.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH COORDINATOR Part-time (20 hours a week Sunday – Thursday, 8am -12pm)

The SPCA Monterey County Community Outreach Coordinator supports a broad array of marketing, communications, and educational programs to help promote the SPCA's many vital programs and services for our community. Assists with the marketing of SPCA Monterey County via social media, including Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, and Twitter; assists with radio, print, and TV Pet of the Weeks; photographs adoptable pets and coordinates volunteer photographers; inputs new pet photos into Shelter Buddy for SPCA team access; supports Humane Education programming; performs website updates; prepares and distributes many digital communications; assists with graphic design; and other duties as assigned. Ideal candidate will be a dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Bilingual in English/Spanish is preferred, but not a must. Must have current California Driver's License and be able to present clean DMV pull at time of interview. Salary range for this position is \$20.00 - \$22.00/hour DOE

REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN – Fulltime & Part-time Positions Available

ANIMAL CARE SPECIALIST (Fulltime 40 hrs/wk: Friday – Tuesday, 8am -5pm)

Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Animal husbandry background preferred.
