## FACILITIES MANAGER (Fulltime 40 hrs/wk: Monday -Friday 8am -5pm)

The Facilities Manager is responsible for managing a hard-working team in overall day-to-day maintenance and safe operation of all SPCA vehicles, buildings, and grounds, including but not limited to electrical systems, plumbing, HVAC, water and sewer systems, landscaping, road and fire road maintenance, etc. Procures, evaluates, and makes recommendations related to competitive bids and proposals from outside vendors to perform maintenance-related services that can't be economically performed in-house. Coordinates all repairs as needed. Ideal candidate will be a dependable self-starter, with strong organizational skills, 3-5 years experience in intermediate maintenance, 2+ years of Management experience and the ability to learn new duties. Represents the SPCA on Pet of the Week segments and in the media as needed; assists with social media and takes photos and videos as needed; and other duties as assigned. Ideal candidate will be a creative, dependable self-starter, with strong organizational skills, a love for children and animals, and the ability to learn new duties. Bilingual in English/Spanish is preferred but not required. A background in education, humane education, or running camp programs is ideal. This full-time position is Tuesday-Saturday during the school year and Monday-Friday during the summer.
