Qualified applicants **must be a California State Certified Licensed RVT**. Ideal candidates will be self-motivated, able to multi-task, have excellent clinical skills and work well with others. Full-time position is Monday – Friday, 7:30am -4pm work shift and Part-time positions vary in time frames, work days and can include Saturdays. Starting rate for these positions is \$25.00 - \$30.00/hour DOE, + \$5,000 Sign on Bonus for Full-time (40hours/week), \$2,500 Sign on Bonus for Part-time (20 hours/week) after 90 days of employment.

VETERINARY ASSISTANT (Fulltime 40 hours a week)

Responsible for assisting with surgery monitoring, recovery, daily cleaning, prepare surgery packs, lift and transport animals and assist in receptionist area when needed. We are looking for an outgoing and welcoming Customer Care Specialist, who will be participating in the adoptions and surrenders of hundreds of homeless animals a year in our Pet Adoption and Intake Center. Experience in customer service/hospitality field is required. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Solid work history and ability to work a flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current California Driver's License. Starting rate for this unique position is \$16.60/hour.

ANIMAL CARE SPECIALIST (Fulltime 40 hours a week)

Join our team working behind the scenes providing quality animal care to the hundreds of animals housed in our shelter each year. Work with the entire Animal Care staff to clean kennels and cages, feed and water a variety of domestic animals and livestock, restock animal supplies, assist with medicating sick animals, assist with the training of new employees and restrain animals for examinations, vaccinations and euthanasia, in accordance with established quality animal care and husbandry standards under the supervision of the Animal Care manager. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Animal husbandry background preferred. Solid work history and ability to work a flexible schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current California Driver's License. Starting rate for this position is \$16.60/hour.

TLC BEHAVIOR ASSISTANT (Fulltime 40 hours a week)

As a TLC Behavior Assistant you are responsible for assisting in the behavior evaluation, training and implementing behavior protocols of Shelter dogs, husbandry of animals that are housed in the TLC building, and other duties as assigned. You will also be working with the public and volunteers, and at times showcasing the dogs in the adoption center, play yards, offsite and on media. TLC dogs are often available by appointment only; you will set up the appointments and meet potential adopters. You will be tracking dog's behavior progress while they are in the TLC program and even after adoption. You will also at times be working with cats that need behavior intervention. Ideal candidate will be dependable self-starter, with the ability to learn new duties. Must have prior Animal Handling and husbandry experience. Certified in Pet Behavior Training using positive reinforcement methods is a plus. Solid work history and ability to work a Tuesday- Saturday schedule, including weekends and holidays, required. Must have current California Driver's License. Starting rate for this position is \$16.60/hour + (DOE & Behavior Certifications).
